How to Launch the service_for Windows

■ Steps

- ※ Please use **Google Chrome** as your browser.
- ① Depending on where Chrome is installed on your PC, double-click one of the following shortcuts:
 - If Chrome is installed in "C:\Program Files\Google\Chrome\Application\chrome.exe"
 - Miraava.Ink
 - If Chrome is installed in "C:\Program Files (x86)\Google\Chrome\Application\chrome.exe"
 - Miraava-x86.Ink
- ② A prompt will appear saying "Do you want to open this file?" — click "Open" to proceed.
 - This message will appear each time, so if desired, you can uncheck the box at the bottom left that says "Always ask before opening this file."
- ④ MIRAAVA will launch in Chrome.
- That's it!

How to Launch the service_for Mac

■ Steps

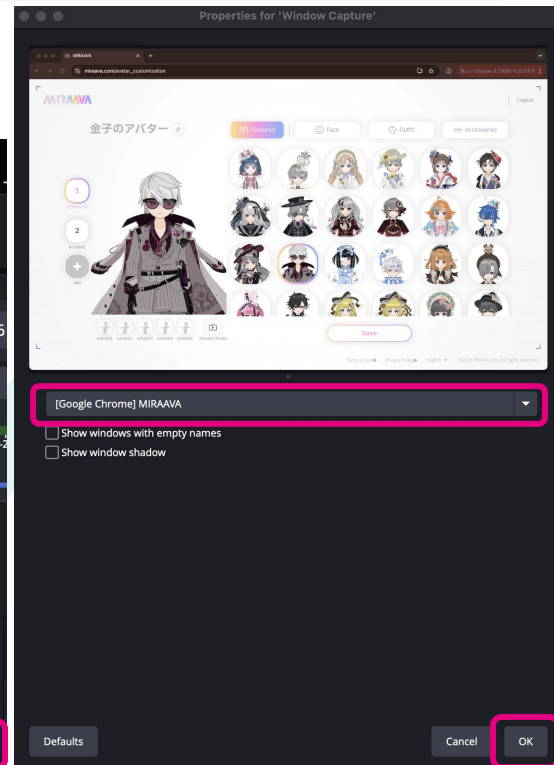
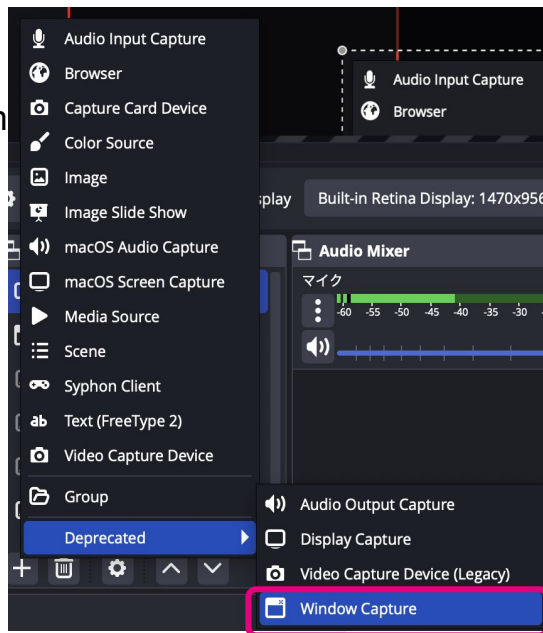
- ※ Please use **Google Chrome** as your browser.
- ① Extract the ZIP file and double-click the MIRAABA application to open it.
- ② If you see a warning saying "MIRAABA cannot be opened,"
 - go to System Settings > Privacy & Security, scroll down to the Security section, and click "Open Anyway" under the message that says something like "MIRAABA was blocked from use because it is not from an identified developer."
 - ※The wording of this alert may vary depending on your macOS version.
- ④ When the alert "Are you sure you want to open MIRAABA?" appears, click "Open".
- ⑤ MIRAABA will launch in Chrome.
- That's it!

How to capture in OBS



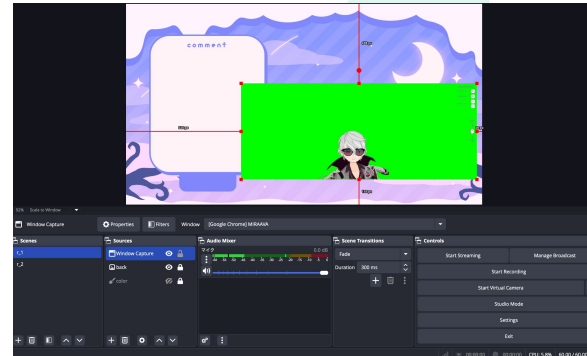
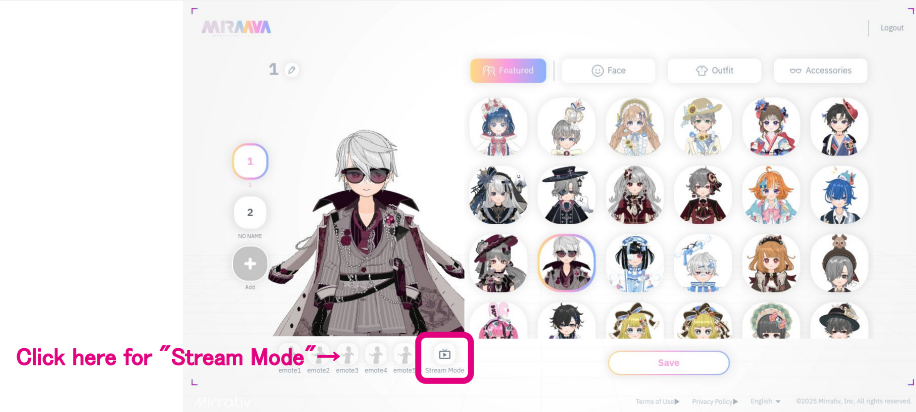
【STEP1】Add MIRAABA from the "Sources" section in OBS Studio.

1. In OBS Studio, go to **"Sources"**
2. Select **"Window Capture"** (it may be listed under "Deprecated")
3. Choose **"Create New"** and click OK
4. Find and select **[Chrome] MIRAABA** from the list
5. Click "OK" to confirm



【STEP2】Adjust the window size

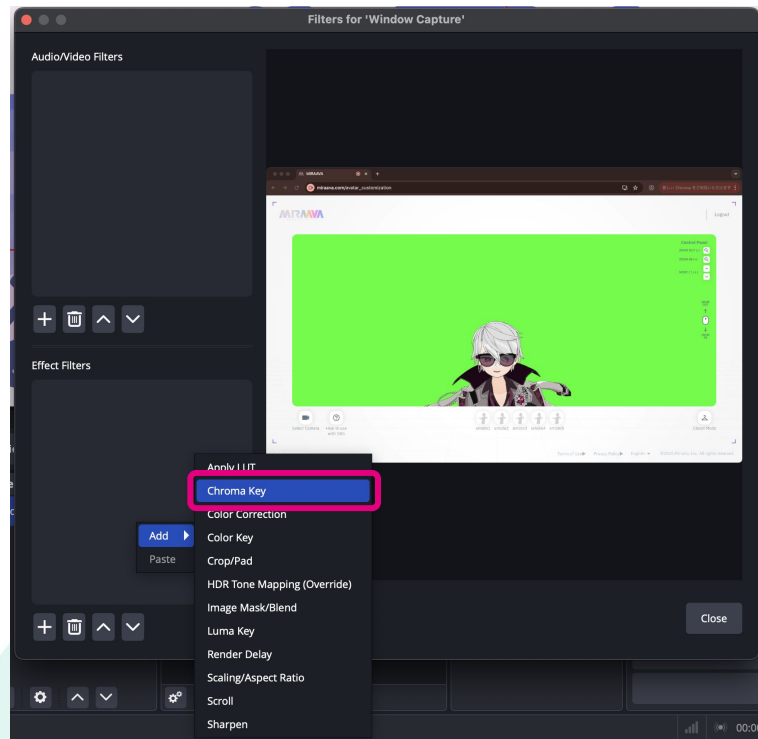
1. Make sure that MIRAABA is set to **"Streaming Mode"**
 2. In OBS, select the MIRAABA window, and resize it so that only the chroma key (green background) area is visible.
 3. To crop the window size in OBS:
 - a. On Windows, hold down the Alt key while resizing.
 - b. On Mac, hold down the Option key while resizing.

【STEP3】Adjust the Chroma key

1. Right-click the window capture added in STEP 1 and select **"Filters"**
2. Click the **"+"** button under Effect Filters, then select **"Add"** → **"Chroma Key"**
 - a. <https://www.mediaequipt.com/how-to-chroma-key-in-obs/>
 - b. ※You can leave the default settings as they are.

- **Now your chroma key setup is complete!**
- Feel free to enjoy using MIRAABA in your streams and recordings.
 - Place the window capture wherever you'd like on your screen layout.
 - (If it doesn't appear on your stream screen)
 - Right-click → Order → Move to Top, and it should show up.



Troubleshooting

■ Case①

- After closing Chrome using the × button or similar methods, there may be cases where the MIRAABA application does not launch when you try to open it again by double-clicking.
- In that case, please completely quit the Chrome application, and then try opening the MIRAABA application again by double-clicking — it should launch properly.

■ Case②

- After launching the application, a Google login screen may appear when Chrome opens.
- In this case, it's perfectly fine whether you choose to log in or not — it will not affect the application's functionality.
